





It has been suggested that Vogeler's "Extase" might have been inspired in some measure by this woodcut of Marc's.






Image 16. Vogeler. *Expressionismus der Liebe*. Pamphlet. (Hanover: Paul Steegeman, 1919). Princeton University Library.
